## Report inactive instagram account

Instagram is one of the most important and popular social networks in the world. But not everyone is so in love with it. And although Instagram started as the first mobile application and still relies heavily on smartphones to succeed in deactivating your Instagram account, you'll have to start booting up the browser. If you really seriously deactivate your Instagram account and want to take steps to do so, we are insured you. How to deactivate your Instagram account: 1. Open your browser and go to Instagram.com.2. Enter your username and password to sign in to your account.3. Click the avatar in the upper-right corner of the page. 4. Click Edit Profile to the right of your user name at the top of the page.5. Scroll down and click Temporarily disable my account. 6. A drop down menu will be displayed. Choose the reason for disabling your account. Enter your account password to confirm that you want to disable your account.7. Click Temporarily disable account, and your account will be disabled. Note that if you deactivate an account this way, all content, including profile, photos, comments, and other likes, will be hidden from view. You can always reactivate your account later to return all your content to your profile. How to delete your Instagram account? want to disable your account and instead want to delete your content, you need to take these steps. Note that using this option to deactivate your Instagram account is permanent. Unlike the previous option, this will remove all your photos, stories, and other content so that these items are no longer available. In other words, if you're really done with Instagram and want to remove everything, that's the way to do it.1. Open your browser and go to Instagram.com.2. Enter your username and password to sign in to your account.3. Unfortunately, Instagram doesn't make its Delete feature easily visible anywhere on the service. But we have you covered. Once you are logged in, click here and you will arrive on the page to delete your account.4. Choose why you delete Instagram from the drop-down menu and re-enter your password in your account.5. Click Permanently delete my account and your account will be deleted. If you add hashtags to your photo, such #landscape or #selfie, anyone looking for the hashtag will be able to find it. Although these defaults work if you are a photographer or brand, some people may feel a bit too public. Let's look at how to make your Instagram account private. Make your account private Open Instagram and go to your profile page. In the upper-right corner, click the Settings icon. This will bring you to the Settings screen. Down down, flip Private Account toggle on. Now only your followers will be able to see your posts. You will also have to confirm anyone new who wants to follow you. Approve new followers If someone new tries to follow you, they will send a follow-up request. The next time you sign in, you'll be notified. Tap the heart icon to view it. On the Notifications screen, you'll see follow-up requests. Tap an area to view them. You can then confirm or delete them. Instagram can be a lot of fun until it doesn't. Many people worry about their privacy through the popular social media network. Others worry that the things they posted above will be used against them. Whatever your situation, you can always delete your Instagram account if you have serious concerns. Deleting an account takes only a few minutes of your time and can save you a lot of heartache in certain situations. There are also some steps you can take before deleting your account to ensure that you make the right decision. Before you delete your Instagram account, make sure you understand the consequences if you do. Deleting your account is the final step, and you won't be able to access anything you'll post again if you do so. All photos, messages, or replies you receive will be lost. Thus, you want to make sure that you save all photos you may not have on your phone or computer, and review your page to search for any contact information you may need. You will also lose your list of followers and personal messages when you delete your account. scyther5 / Getty Images Before deleting your account, consider the fact that Instagram allows you to control all your data that has been published on the site. You might want to review your data and see if better privacy controls better suit your needs than deleting your entire account. To do this, access Instagram on the web or phone and click the settings icon that looks like the sun. Click Privacy & Security, and then scroll down to Account Details and choose View account details. You can do this by opening the settings icon, and then choosing Privacy & Security. Scroll down until 'Data download' appears, and then choose Request download. You will be asked for your email and Instagram password. Note that downloads can take up to 48 hours before you receive a download link from Instagram. Chesnot/Getty Images instagram by default will make your profile and posts public, but you can choose to change your privacy settings and limit who can view your information. This may be the case to protect you against someone getting ahold of your information that you don't want too. Before deleting your account, consider opening your privacy settings and reviewing your settings. To do this, open the person icon at the top of the screen next to your username, and then choose Account Privacy, change the setting to Private account, and review what's available to others. HYWARDS/Getty Images If you're not entirely sure if you want to delete your Instagram account, you might want to temporarily disable your account. When you disable an account, all your photos, comments, profile, and likes are hidden in public view. To do this, log on to your account from your computer, and then click the profile icon in the upper-right corner. Choose Edit Profile and scroll down until Temporarily disable my account is displayed. Rent your password and choose the reason why. Then just choose Temporarily disable account again, and your account will remain disabled until you log back on. You can't use the Instagram app to delete your app. Therefore, you will need to open a mobile browser or get to your computer to do so. If you don't have a computer, you can always go to a public place like a library to do this. It will only take you a few minutes to complete the process. When you're signed in to the Instagram website, go to a page called Delete your account. Select it and you will be asked to enter your password again. You will also be asked Why do you delete your account? You must select a reason from the menu to continue. After you have chosen one, you will be asked to insert your password again, and then you can select the final option to permanently delete my account. After clicking on this your account will be gone. lechatnoir/Getty Images If you have a second account then you will need a lot back before doing so. Choose the sun icon next to your username, and choose Log off. Then, log on with the account information that you want to delete below. Just follow the same instructions in the previous step, and you can delete the second account in just a few minutes. This applies to parents who want to delete a child's account, or to adults who want to disable someone's account that has disappeared. The only way to delete an account is by logging into an account with the appropriate username and password and choosing to delete it.
